There are two categories – *Achiever* and *Young Achiever* – with the winners decided by a panel consisting of the region's leading hospitality educators.

Candidates for the *Achiever* category will be nominated and judged by the organising panel, as listed on the opposite page. Candidates for the *Young Achiever* category must be nominated by their head of department/company, and complete the attached entry form.

CRITERIA:

ACHIEVER

- Candidates must be aged 31 and over, and working full time in the hospitality industry in Asia Pacific;
- They must demonstrate ongoing commitment to the industry;
- They must be innovative;
- They must be dedicated to maintaining the highest levels of training and educational standards, including mentoring colleagues;
- They must be able to demonstrate a commitment to the highest levels of business practices, as well as dedication to the community.

YOUNG ACHIEVER

- Candidates must be aged 30 or under, and working full time in the hospitality industry in the Asia Pacific region;
- They must be able to demonstrate their commitment to the industry, their ability to contribute to the industry in future and their self-development efforts over and above their duty requirements;
- Candidates must be proposed and endorsed by the head of their organisation or their GM;
- All nominations must be accompanied by a full CV;
- There is no limit to the number of nominations submitted by each proposer. However, the proposer cannot be the candidate himself/herself.
